Grades K/1

Individual Materials (please label)

- Backpack (Regular sized, no wheels so it fits in a locker)
- 1 heavy duty plastic 2 pocket take-home folder, BLUE

Shared materials (DO NOT label)

- 1 large package paper bowls, food boats, or small paper cups (Dixie)
- 1 box of healthy storable snacks (crackers, granola bars, apple sauce, etc.)
- 2 pink pearl erasers
- 1 watercolor paint set (8 colors)
- 1 box of **Crayola** crayons (box of 24)
- 12, #2 **Ticonderoga** pencils, sharpened, if possible.
- 1 box tissues
- 8 thin black **Expo** dry erase marks
- 3 two-pocket PAPER folders with prongs (1 each: red, green, blue)



Grades 2/3

Individual Materials (please label)

- 1 backpack or book bag

Shared materials (DO NOT label)

- 1 box of **Crayola** wide markers, classic colors
- 1 box of **Crayola** thin markers, classic colors
- 1 box of **Crayola** crayons (box of 24)
- 1 box of **Crayola** colored pencils
- 1 pack of **Ticonderoga** pencils, 24/box. Sharpened, if possible.
- 2 large pink erasers
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 box facial tissue
- 2 packages notebook paper, wide-ruled
- 1 composition book, wide-ruled
- 1 spiral notebook, wide-ruled

Grades 4/5

Individual Materials (please label)

- 1 backpack or book bag
- 1 two-inch 3-ring binder
- Headphones or earbuds (optional)

Shared materials (DO NOT label)

- 1 pack of **Ticonderoga** pencils, 24/box (sharpened)
- 1 set of 5 tab dividers (Do not label before school.)
- 1 box of facial tissues
- 2 packages Lysol disinfecting wipes
- 1 independent book to read (So kids are ready for independent reading on Day 1!)
- 1 ream of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 package of healthy storable snacks (ex: granola bars, apple sauce, crackers, popcorn)
- 1 package glue sticks

Art/Technology

Art/Technology classroom is in need of the following.

- Crayola colored pencils & markers

Nurse's Station

- Jeans / sweatpants / stretch pants (gently used, all sizes)
- Underwear / socks (new, all sizes)

Office

The office is always in need of supplies throughout the school year:

- Blank greeting cards / thank you cards (odds & ends, left overs)
- Neon (Bright) copy paper
- Themed "use but don't take" pens. (Pens with flowers, etc.)

Journey (Grades 6/7/8)

Instead of using shared materials, our Journey students will be building the life skill of responsibility by bringing and managing their own supplies. Please label appropriately.

Our experience is that some shared supplies are still needed so students are successful in the classroom, those are listed as well.

Individual Materials (please label)

- Gridded (graph, not lined) composition books: **4 per student. Bring only 3 to school the first day, labeled.**
- Grades 7/8 – **Students need a calculator.** We suggest a Scientific calculator that will be usable through grade 12. (TI-30XA preferred)
- All students need one of these for organizational purposes.
 - 1 (or more) 1.5" 3-ring binder with dividers, with clear plastic cover OR
 - 1 large accordion file.
 - A set of 6, two-pockets folders. Plastic hold up better if students are using these daily.
 - Let your student offer input on how they plan to organize themselves.
- Writing and Art supplies (pen, pencil, glue stick, colored pencils, ruler, markers, etc.)
- Backpack or book bag

Shared in the classroom

- 2 full-size boxes of facial tissues
- Pencils – 96 count (Prefer Dixon Ticonderoga)
- Ball point pens (blue or black) – 1 box of 12 count
- Glue sticks – 6 count

Later in the year...

- Walking/hiking shoes for overnight camps / field trips
- 1 trifold board for Science Fair (Spring) and other presentations

STEAM class (optional, always needed):

- Straws (full-size & skinny)
- Scrap wood (discuss with Becca before bringing wood)
- Paper/plastic cups
- Hot Glue sticks
- Masking tape
- Duct tape

5th & 6th Grade Band/Orchestra
