Our most cherished tradition, Camp takes kids out of the classrooms for a few days each spring and fall. Families (including younger siblings) are invited to attend at no cost. Attending Camp truly cements our relationship as a small school community.

Market Day

Three times a year, students participate in a token-based economy as buyers and sellers. Their "accounts" roll over each market day, so they learn how to save and make money. Student Vendors must complete a business proposal and pay start-up costs.

Electives

A few times a year, parents join the classrooms to shake up the curriculum and give kids a chance to try something new. They offer two elective sessions, which could include anything from Rubik's cube to cooking to LEGO engineering to fire safety.
